## St. Clement's Group Reunion

Starting sometime at the beginning of the Pandemic, our St. Clement's Saturday Morning Men's Reunion Group began meeting on Zoom, rather than in our Parish Hall, which had been occurring for over two decades. Attendees would vary from two or three -- or as many as seven or eight -- before the Pandemic.

The change to Zoom seemed to be met at first by long term attendees as a welcome alternative during the Pandemic's changing conditions. No one knew at that time that the Pandemic scourge would last three years, and teach us much about our political, healthcare, and personal choices.

Today, we still meet by Zoom on Saturday morning, from 8:00 till 9:00. And there has been a noticeable shift in attendees. We now have attendees from:

- ◆ St. Christophers—an attendee who has been instrumental in reviving St. Christopher's Episcopal in High Point.
- ◆ St. Timothy's—a 91-year-old retired physician, whose life perspectives and medical experience are regular contributions to our Saturday Check-ins.
- ◆ St. Anne's—originally from New York City, who attended EFM (Education for Ministry) locally, is active in St. Anne's, and brings a rich perspective re. the African American and Gay communities.
- ◆ St. Clement's—two, sometimes three or - even four, active, regular attendees.
- ◆ A new attendee, who recently moved from Wilmington to Pilot Mountain, and was very active in Cursillo in our Eastern NC Episcopal Diocese.
- ◆ A new attendee, who attends a Presbyterian church in Raleigh. He found our Men's Reunion Group Saturday personal spiritual discussions helpful or a personal challenge he found himself in the middle of nine months ago.

Our discussions follow the Cursillo Fourth Day Guidelines:

Prayer of the Holy Spirit, followed by personal witness discussions regarding:

PIETY: including one moment in which you felt closest to Christ, and why.

STUDY: share one thing you have done to increase your understanding of your relationship with God and His Creation.

ACTION: If you have had a specific plan for attempting to witness or serve the lord in some area, share one success, or disappointment you have experienced. What unexpected opportunity to witness has the lord offered you?

### Closing Prayer

I assure you, we each leave our Saturday morning's group discussions, better prepared to face the coming day and week!

Also, our Cursillo Ministry offers an Ultreya every 60 days, where a Cursillista volunteer offers an inspiring Witness Talk, followed by a Clergy Response.
